

## GENERAL COMPETITION RULES

- 1.** Student competition is open to all current students with proof of enrollment and hours.
- 2.** All contestants must be pre-registered.
- 3.** It is the responsibility of each competitor to furnish their model, tools, supplies, etc at their own risk.
- 4.** Competitors and models may not leave the competition area after the competition has begun and may only be excused by the competition chairman. Anyone found leaving the area without permission will be disqualified. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 5.** Competitors are not allowed or permitted to touch their models after they have been seated in the competition area until the competition chairman directs them.
- 6.** If there is coaching by anyone in the audience to any competitor, the competition chairman will deduct points from the competitors score.
- 7.** Flash photography is not allowed during the competition.
- 8.** Should there be an infraction of the rules by any competitor, or if in the opinion of the competition committee that the infraction should be penalized, the competition chairman may assess penalties of 1, 2 or 3 points per jury members depending on the severity of the infraction.

# STUDENT TEAM COMPETITION

## Specific Rules:

1. The category is “50’s-60’s Celebrity Look Alike”.
2. One and half (1.5) hours will be allowed to complete both phases: Hair and Makeup
3. Model shall be dressed in there attire. Absolutely no nudity. Attire will be 25% of total score.
4. Model will come with a clean face. Makeup is to be applied in the allotted time.
5. Theme hair will be pre-set and dried and must be combed out by one team member. Any method of setting is allowed, however, all hair must be combed. It is to be completed in the allotted time. (there are no electrical outlets).
6. Ornamentation may be used but not to cover more than one quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the competed hairstyle.
7. Hair piece may not cover more than  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the skull area.
8. Models will be judged on suitability, creativity and workmanship.
